

Danish editor <u>Niels Pagh Andersen</u>, the author of *Order in Chaos*, visited South Africa recently, and SAGE, in conjunction with the <u>DFA</u>, <u>Centre for Humanities</u>

Research, Goethe Institute, RCL Africa, docLOVE, docSHARE, UCT Film & Media, Uhuru Productions, Surplus Radical Bookshop and Wesgro, hosted a masterclass and an industry roundtable with filmmakers and editors towards sharing ideas and processes in Cape Town and Johannesburg. *The Look of Silence* and *The Act of Killing* were screened, both edited by Niels.

This year is a virtual event and is open to independent African documentary projects with a working rough cut.

SAGE held a Rough Cut Lab for Feature Films in 2021.

Karien van Biljon was the Cinematic VR Artisan who worked on *Gorilla-Trek*, a Virtual Reality Production, which <u>won the prestigious Lumière Award</u> at the

Advanced Imaging Society's 2023 event, in the Best Use of VR category. She was responsible for 85% of the <u>Onlining Process</u>, <u>which involved Stitching</u>, <u>Roto Painting</u>, <u>Online Editing and Finishing</u>, and helped with the preliminary shot selections.

Andrea Shaw S.A.G.E. recently worked on the Cape Town drama <u>Spinners</u>, a collaboration between <u>Showmax & Canal+</u>, with fellow SAGE member **Stephen** Abbott S.A.G.E. and Matthew Swanepoel. The eight-episode action-drama series received a <u>Best Series nomination at the sixth edition of Cannes Series</u>. The nomination marks the first African series selected in the history of The Cannes International Series Festival.

<u>The Colonel's Stray Dogs</u>, by **Khalid Shamis S.A.G.E.**, was recently screened by <u>docLOVE</u> on 14 April at the Isivivana Centre Cinema in Khayelitsha.

Waiting for the Sibyl, a chamber opera with projected animation film created, conceptualised and directed by William Kentridge, with edited and designed projection by **Žana Marović** won the best achievement in Opera at the Laurence Olivier Awards 2023 held in London. The Laurence Olivier Awards, or simply the Olivier Awards, are presented annually by the Society of London Theatre to recognise excellence in professional theatre in London at an annual ceremony in the capital.

Catherine Meyburgh S.A.G.E. is working on the performance <u>The Head and the</u> <u>Load</u>, which opens on 21 April at the Joburg theatre and runs until 6 May. She did the projection design.
