## **Rough Cut Lab**

Our third Rough Cut Lab, in collaboration with <u>Encounters South African</u> <u>International Documentary Film Festival</u> and <u>The Refinery</u>, kicked off on Saturday, 29 May. It is funded by the <u>NFVF</u>, and sponsored by <u>frame.io</u>.

This year a total of eight documentary films were selected. Unlike in previous years, the Lab is conducted remotely because of Covid-19 restrictions, but this has resulted in turning it into a pan-African initiative.

The Lab is organised by Khalid Shamis S.A.G.E., and the 2021 consultants are Catherine Meyburgh S.A.G.E., Melissa Parry S.A.G.E., Sarah Dawson, Najwa Khechemi, Hajooj Kuka and Marouan O'mara. The films selected are *Basotho: Life in Three Tales, Diary of an Elephant Orphan, Frances Baard - the Spirit, Ithemba Lyiaphilisa, Last Blue Ride, Notes from the Underground, Requiem for a Megacity and Truck Mama.* The Lab will conclude on 12 June.
